Biomed Students on Quest to Modernize Childbirth Tools

A project by four biomedical engineering students seeks to speed up assisted vaginal births while addressing the needs of the mom, her doctor and the baby. Piggybacking on work done earlier by two other students, Maddie Mumford, Brittany Trinh, Jenna Eissmann and Rachel Rowe are testing their sling prototype they hope inspires the medical community to embrace modernized birthing devices like theirs. After consulting with obstetricians-gynecologists, they identified a need for a device to manage shoulder dystocia — a condition where a baby's shoulders become lodged during vaginal delivery, necessitating reliance on 25-30 manual maneuvers by doctors.
